

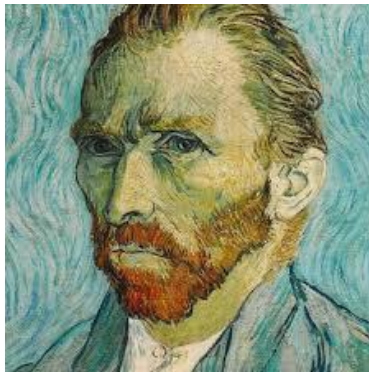
# Observational Drawing

## Paint, inspired by direct observation

- Know that impressionism captured a momentary sensory effect of a scene or object
- Know that the way impressionists painted was loose to represent the impression an object made on the eye in a fleeting instant
- Develop the skill to use paint in an impressionist style
- Link art to emotion through own sensory experience of sunflowers
- Observe a sunflower and use colour, texture and shape to paint in the style of the impressionists
- Know key facts about Vincent Van Gogh, the importance of 'Sunflowers' and why impressionism is one of the most recognisable painting style in art history

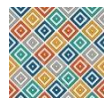
